### Celebrate with Bells

Historically bells have been rung during the Gloria at Mass on Holy Thursday and then the Mass took a more solemn tone as the Triduum (from the Latin meaning *three days*) began. Bells were not rung again until the singing of the Gloria at the Great Easter Vigil thus signifying a celebration of the end of the Lenten fast.



*We invite you to bring bells of any kind to ring during the Gloria on Holy Thursday (March 29<sup>th</sup>), the Easter Vigil (March 31<sup>st</sup>) and for all Masses on Easter Sunday (April 1<sup>st</sup>).*
