

St. Andrew CCW Meeting Minutes
January 20, 2020

Call to Order: President, Anna Johnson, opened the meeting with prayer to Our Lady of Good Counsel.

Roll Call: Anna Johnson, President; Jenny Thesing, Vice President; Melissa Fussy, Treasurer; Arlene Jackson, Secretary; Pat Wlasiuk, St. Patrick's; Judy Toft, St. Clare's.

Approval of Minutes: Judy Toft made a motion to approve the November 18, 2019, minutes. Pat Wlasuik seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Treasurer's Report: Melissa presented the six month Treasurer's Report for the period ending December, 2019, to each member. We have a checking account balance of \$5,355.17 and a savings account balance of \$1,609.20. The scholarship account balance is \$1,864.86. The scholarship annuity balance is \$7,240.06 as of 11/30/19.

Deanery Report: The Spring CCW Conference will be held on Tuesday, May 19, at St. Andrew's Church. Pat Walsh would like the poster for the conference by February 11. Various committee leaders were designated to begin the planning process. Pat and Anna will take the lead on planning the breakfast and luncheon. Judy will coordinate the Raffle Table. Anna and Jenny will handle programs, Liturgy and schedule coordination and advertising. Arlene will be in charge of the Registration Table.

Pastoral Council Report: None

Guild Reports:

St. Anne's: Anna reported they had Coffee Sunday in December and since there were five Sundays in December, the St. Vincent de Paul Society took one Sunday. Everything went well.

St. Anthony's: Arlene reported they had a Christmas Party in December and will have Coffee Sundays in February. During Advent, the Guild sold angels as a fundraiser to support Diocese of Duluth Seminarians. After expenses, the net profit from angel sales was \$352.90. This amount was less than previous years, but since some of the angels were purchased from the Kobonal Mission in Haiti, the Mission also was supported by the angel sales. There are over 20 ornaments left from Haiti.

Arlene made a motion to donate \$500.00 to the Diocese of Duluth to support the Seminarians. Pat Wlasuik seconded the motion. The motion passed.

St. Clare's: Judy reported they had their Christmas Party at Melissa's house and worked on cards for shut-ins. They will be serving at the Soup Kitchen next Thursday.

St. Mary's: Jenny reported they had the Turkey Bingo in November and served 135. Profits to date are \$1,330.

St. Patrick's: Pat reported they had a Christmas Brunch at Jan Fredstrom's house and chose their prayer partners for the next year. They also served Coffee Sundays in January.

Old Business:

Advent and Lenten Booklets: The CCW voted by email and ordered 200 Advent booklets. Discussion ensued on Lenten Booklets.

Motion by Judy to again purchase Lenten Booklets for adults and children. Pat Wlasuik seconded the motion. The motion passed.

New Business:

Ham Bingo: A tentative date was picked for Ham Bingo for March 21 and Turkey Bingo for November 21. Committees will stay the same as in previous years. Arlene will make sure the CUF Logo is on the poster, and Iris will be asked to apply for the \$200 scholarship from CUF.

Lenten Suppers: Discussion was held on the Lenten Suppers. Some guilds will be making soup and St. Anthony's Guild would like to serve sandwiches like last year. It was agreed the name should be changed from Lenten Soup Suppers to just Lenten Suppers. Arlene will contact the Church secretaries with this change.

Women's Conference Bus: Jenny is once again coordinating the bus to the Women's Conference in Duluth on March 28. Discussion ensued on charges for the bus and opening the bus up to other Brainerd Deanery Churches. It was agreed women from the Brainerd area churches will have priority until March 1 for riding the bus. After March 1, women from outside the Brainerd area will be allowed to fill up the bus.

Motion by Jenny for the CCW to help offset the bus price for the women attending the Women's Conference and charge women from St. Andrew's/St. Mathias/St. Francis/All Saints Churches \$10.00 and women from other parishes \$15.00 for the bus ride to the Women's Conference in Duluth. The CCW will pick up any additional costs above what the women pay. Pat Wlasuik seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Seminarian List: Anna presented everyone with a list of Seminarians for the Diocese of Duluth and the names were distributed to the guilds. The guilds will send cards/gifts to the seminarians.
