

St. Andrew CCW Meeting Minutes
November 18, 2019

Call to Order: President, Anna Johnson, opened the meeting with prayer to Our Lady of Good Counsel.

Roll Call: Anna Johnson, President; Jenny Thesing, Vice President; Melissa Fussy, Treasurer; Arlene Jackson, Secretary; Karen Reither, Past President; Pat Wlasiuk, St. Patrick's; Mary Jo Best, St. Anthony's; Judy Toft, St. Clare's.

Approval of Minutes: Mary Jo Best made a motion to approve the October 21, 2019, minutes. Pat Wlasiuk seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Treasurer's Report: We have a checking account balance of \$6,162.34 and a savings account balance of \$1,609.12. The scholarship account balance is \$680.56. The scholarship annuity balance is \$7,229.80. To date, the CCW has received \$1,815 for Support Sunday.

Diocesan Report: Anna has been trying to contact someone in the Diocesan Office to get a new list of Seminarians, but to date has been unable to get a list. She will keep trying to get a list.

Deanery Report: The Spring CCW Conference will be held on Tuesday, May 19, at St. Andrew's Church. Planning will begin in January. There will be various committees assigned to help organize this event (advertising/meals/registration, etc.).

We will continue to try to engage younger women of the Church to join a Guild. A few women signed up at Support Sunday interested in joining a guild. Some members were given to St. Clare's Guild and one member was given to St. Anthony's Guild. The leaders will contact these women and invite them to join their guilds.

Pastoral Council Report: None

Guild Reports:

St. Anne's: Anna reported they have Coffee Sunday in December and since there are five Sundays in December, the St. Vincent de Paul Society will take December 8.

St. Anthony's: Mary Jo reported they served the Soup Kitchen on Halloween to approximately 47 people and everything went well. Angel sales will start next Sunday and they will have their Christmas Party for members and spouses on December 9.

St. Clare's: Judy reported they finished up their Appalachia gifts. They've been serving Coffee Sundays in November and have three new guild members.

St. Mary's: Jenny reported they will have Turkey Bingo Saturday evening and everything is all set except for the cash, which Melissa will provide for them.

St. Patrick's: Pat noted they finished their Appalachia gifts and met for Rosary and petitions.

Old Business:

Parish Mission: Anna thanked everyone for their help preparing and serving meals at the Parish Mission. Approximately 85-90 people ate each evening and all went well. There was lots of leftover food which Melissa took to the Women's Shelter, and they were very grateful for the leftovers.

New Business:

Turkey Bingo: Turkey Bingo is set for this Saturday, November 23. Jenny stated she has enough volunteers and all is ready to go. There will be a bill coming for printing of flyers at Lakes Printing.

Christmas for Clergy: Pat Wlasuik made a motion to give each priest \$75 and each deacon \$25 for Christmas gifts. Mary Jo Best seconded the motion. The motion passed.

Angel Sales for Vocations: Mary Jo reported Angel sales start this Sunday. The ornaments received from the Kobonal Mission in Haiti were not all angels. Due to the unrest in Haiti, not enough angels were available, so other ornaments were sent, including hearts and doves. The ornaments from the Kobonal Mission will be sold for \$8.00 and there will be glass ornaments sold for \$5.00 as in past years. Ornament sales will benefit the Kobonal Mission as well as the Seminarians.

Coffee Sundays: It was agreed when there are five Sundays in a month, there is the option for the Guild Leader to offer one of the Sundays to another group as a fundraiser for that group. Other groups might include: St. Vincent de Paul, Knights of Columbus, Men's Group, and Youth Groups.

Society of St. Vincent de Paul: Pat Wlasuik presented a request by the St. Teresa of Calcutta's Society of St. Vincent de Paul for a monetary donation from the CCW. The St. Vincent de Paul Society provides individuals or families who need a helping hand assistance when requested due to job loss, illness/medical bills, car repairs, rent/utility assistance or other emergency needs. In the first nine months, the Society has given over \$14,500 to neighbors in crisis. Discussion ensued.

Motion by Judy Toft to give the St. Teresa of Calcutta's Society of St. Vincent de Paul a monetary donation of \$500. Mary Jo Best seconded the motion. The motion passed. (Pat Wlasuik abstained from voting since she presented the request and is a member of St. Vincent de Paul.)

December Coffee – St. Anne's and St. Vincent de Paul on December 8.

Women's Conference – March 28 – a bus has been reserved already.

Meeting adjourned with Prayer for Priests.
