FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- ❖ **What should I put for my child's/children's grade?**
 - ❖ Please list the grade that your child will be in when they start school in fall 2018.

- ❖ **Do I have to pay the \$20 First Eucharist fee?**
 - ❖ Yes, an additional \$20 First Eucharist fee is due for each child who will receive their First Eucharist in 2019. This fee covers the cost of extra resources and the retreat.

- ❖ **Do I have to pay the \$50 Confirmation fee for Confirmation I (Grade 9) and Confirmation II (Grade 10)?**
 - ❖ Yes, an additional \$50 Confirmation fee is due for each child registered in the Confirmation I & II program. This fee covers the cost of speakers and the retreats.

- **What if I'm short of funds right now?**
 - ❖ Please do not delay completing & submitting your registration due to finances. Payment plans can always be arranged to suit your family. No one will be turned away because of a lack of funds. Please speak with the Faith Formation office about your situation. We are here to help!

- **What do I have to do if my child is going into Grade 2, but hasn't been in Grade 1?**
 - ❖ Please contact us to discuss your child's situation as soon as possible. We are always willing to work with families providing assistance for sacramental preparation and formation. Our First Eucharist program is a two year program regardless of grade.

- **What do I have to do if my child is going into Grade 10, but hasn't completed the Confirmation I class?**

- **What if my child is entering/attending Catholic School?**
 - ❖ Catholic school students entering grades 2 & 10 and needing sacrament preparation for First Eucharist and Confirmation must register and attend classes.
