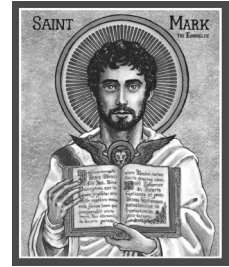

SAINT OF THE WEEK: Monday—St. George (d.303), martyr and patron of England, and St. Adalbert (956-997), martyr; Tuesday—St. Fidelis of Sigmaringen (1577-1622), priest and martyr; Wednesday—St. Mark the Evangelist, patron of notaries and lawyers; Saturday—St. Peter Chanel (1803-1841), priest and martyr, St. Louis Grignon (1673-1716), priest known for his particular devotion to the Blessed Virgin Mary and the practice of praying the Rosary, and St. Gianna Beretta Molla (1922-1962), Italian pediatrician who refused an abortion while pregnant with her 4th child, knowing that it could result in her own death (which occurred).
