SAINTS OF THE WEEK: Monday—St. Augustine Zhao Rong and Companions (1648-1930), 120 Chinese martyrs (priest, children, parents, catechists and laborers), canonized by St. John Paul II in 2000; Wednesday—St. Benedict (480-547), Patriarch of Western monasticism, Patron of Europe; Patriarch of Western monasticism; Friday—St. Henry (973-1024), Emperor of Bavaria; Saturday—St. Kateri Tekakwitha (1656-1680), "Lily of the Mohawks," canonized in 2012, the first Native American saint.
