## LENTEN DISCIPLINES OF FASTING AND ABSTINENCE

Intentionally Good Friday is a day of fasting and abstinence for Catholics. The Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence. Fasting is for those age 18-59. Eat one full meal, as well as two smaller meals together that are not equal to a full meal. We do this to join in solidarity with those suffering throughout our world. • Abstinence is for those age 14 and older. Avoid meat (beast or fowl) or rich food on Fridays. This practice is an invitation to grow in discipleship by deepening our personal awareness of dependence on God.
