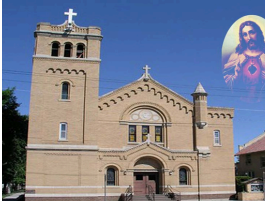

That’s because Ordinary Time begins after the Feast of the Baptism of the Lord, but the following Sunday is immediately counted as the Second Sunday in Ordinary Time. The “first” week happens quietly during the weekdays but never gets its own Sunday! So happy First Monday of Ordinary Time!
