PILGRIMAGE

Join **Father Jolly** on a spiritual pilgrimage from Lourdes to Fatima, October 1–14, 2026. The journey begins in Paris with a visit to the Miraculous Medal Shrine, followed by an overnight stay in Nevers to see the incorrupt body of St. Bernadette. From there, travel to Toulouse to visit the tomb of St. Thomas Aquinas, and then continue to Lourdes. While in Lourdes, experience the Grotto, the Baths, the life-size Stations of the Cross, local museums, and a walking tour of St. Bernadette's life, including her birthplace at Boly Mill and the jailhouse known as Le Cachot. The pilgrimage continues into Spain with a visit to the historic castle of St. Ignatius Loyola, followed by time in Garabandal, where you will visit the House of Mary and take in the beauty of the Cantabrian Mountains. You will also visit the medieval city associated with St. Teresa and stop in Salamanca to see her birthplace. The final days are spent in Aljustrel and Valinhos, visiting the homes of the Fatima children and the site of Archangel Michael's apparitions. The pilgrimage concludes in Fatima with the celebration of the Feast Day, including the Candlelight Vigil and International Mass at the Cova da Iria.
