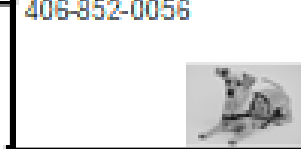

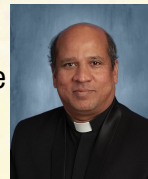


**KNIGHTS OF COLUMBUS BREAKFAST**

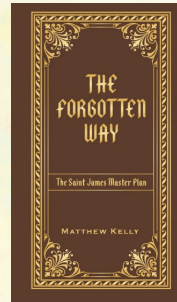
