SAINTS AND FEAST DAYS OF THE WEEK: Monday—

St. Clare, virgin (1193-1253) received the habit from St. Francis of Assissi; Tuesday—St. Jane Frances de Chantal, religious (1572-1641), After the death of her husband St. Jane Frances founded the Congregation of the Visitation, for women who wished to live a religious life without the austerity of existing religious orders. She died having established about 85 Convents; Wednesday-St. Pontian, pope & martyr, and St. Hippolytus, priest & martyr, Hippolytus, disagreed with Pope Callistus way of forgiveness to those who left the church because of fear of persecution. His followers elected him Pope. Pontian was elected Pope after Callistus. Both were sent to the mines in Sardinia, were they died. Before passing Hippolytus was reconciled to the Church and Pontian sent word back saying he would not return; **Thursday—**St. Maximilian Kolbe, priest & martyr (1894-1941), a Franciscan priest who printed religious magazines and newspapers to spread God's word. He was killed the day before the Assumption of the Birgin Mary in Auschwitz; Friday— The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary, Saturday—St. Stephen of Hungary, (c.975-1038), he trained clergy and build churches, and known for his concern for the poor. He was sent a crown by Pop Sylvester II, the crown is still treasured in Hungary.
