



Sacred Heart Class of 1985! We're thrilled to celebrate your 40-year class reunion—what a milestone! Here's to old friends, cherished memories, and the joy of being together again.

SAINTS AND FEAST DAYS OF THE WEEK: Tuesday—St. John Eudes, priest (1601-1680), was born in Normandy and was ordained after joining the Paris Oratory. He cared for victims of the plague and was known to be a passionate preacher; **Wednesday—**St. Bernard, abbot & doctor of the Church (1090-1153), a born leader, called four brothers, a cousin, an uncle and his own father to join the Abby at Clairvaux (the Valley of Light) where he was immediately named Abbot, he was known for his peace making skills, sermons, letters, treaties and biblical commentaries; Thursday—St.



Pius X, pope (1853-1914), was known as the gentle priest. Today we celebrate Pope St. Pius X, Co-Patron of our Diocese! Known for his deep humility and bold reforms, he famously said: "Restore all things in Christ!" He encouraged frequent reception of the Eucharist and worked to deepen the Church's spiritual life. St. Pius X, pray for us and guide our Dio-

cese in holiness and truth! Friday—The Queenship of the Blessed Virgin Mary, Instituted by Pius XII to remind us to recognize the maternal rule of the Mother of God. It is celebrated on the octave, 8days, or the Assumption of the Virgin Mary; Saturday—St. Rose of Lima, virgin (1586-1617), was born in Lima Peru, were she spent her entire life caring for her garden and those who needed her care. She is the Patron Saint of South America and is widely praised throughout Center America.
