SAINTS AND FEAST DAYS OF THE WEEK: **Monday**—St. Louis (1214-1270) and St. Joseph Calasanz, priest (1556-1648); **Wednesday**—St. Monica (332-387) is the mother of Saint Augustine. Through her example her husband and her son became Christians. When Saint Augustine was baptized Saint Monica died knowing all her hopes had been fulfilled; **Thursday**—St. Augustine, bishop & doctor of the Church (354-430) he followed a Persian prophet before hearing St. Ambrose preach. St Augustine was baptized a Christian, then ordained and became bishop of Hippo; **Friday**—The Passion of St. John the Baptist (c.27) spoke out against the marriage of Herod and Herodias. He was thrown in prison and then beheaded, because Herodias saw him as a threat. Herod beheaded St. John the Baptist as a promise to Herodias' daughter.

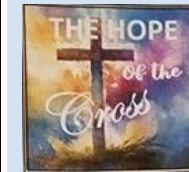

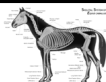
