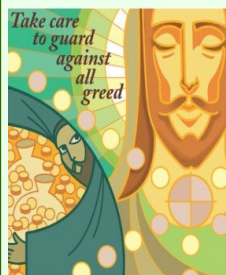

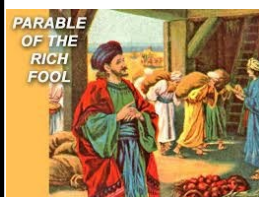

SAINTS AND FEAST DAYS OF THE WEEK:

Monday—St. John Vianney, priest (1786-1859), known as the Curé of Ars and renowned as a confessor; **Tuesday**—The Dedication of the Basilica of Saint Mary Major, dedicated to the praise of Mary the Mother of God; **Wednesday**—The Transfiguration of the Lord, On Mount Tabor, Jesus revealed His divine glory to Peter, James, and John—His face shining like the sun, His clothes dazzling white. In that moment, the veil was lifted, and the apostles caught a glimpse of the glory of God. This feast reminds us that Christ is both fully human and fully divine, and it invites us to be *transformed* by His presence in our own lives. **Thursday**—St. Sixtus II, pope & martyr, and Companions, martyrs (d. 258), executed during the persecution of Christians during the reign of emperor Valerian; St. Cajetan, priest (1480-1547), helped form a society of diocesan priests called the Theatines, who would own no property, lived in community and take monastic vows; **Friday**—St. Dominic, priest (c. 1170-1221), Known for his deep devotion to the Holy Rosary and his tireless preaching, Dominic inspired a renewal of faith in a time of confusion and division. **Saturday**—St. Teresa Benedicta of the Cross, virgin & martyr (1891-1942), born a Jew in Germany, converted to Catholicism and joined the Carmelites, martyred in the gas chambers at Auschwitz.

He was then assigned to undertake theological studies at the Pontifical North American College in Rome, earning a Bachelor's degree in Sacred Theology from the University of St. Thomas in the City and a Diploma in the Theology of the Liturgy from the University of the Holy Cross. He is currently serving as the Pastor at St. Patrick's in Crosby, ND and its mission churches while he completes his graduate degree). 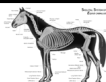
