QUESTION: WHY DO CATHOLICS GENUFLICT BEFORE ENTERING THE PEW?

Answer: Genuflection is an act of reverence toward Jesus truly present in the Eucharist in the tabernacle. By bending the knee, we acknowledge Christ as Lord and center our hearts on His presence before we pray. But this small gesture also asks something of us: Are we truly aware of Who we are kneeling before? Our faith is more than routine or habit. Each prayer, each sign of the cross, each moment at Mass is an invitation to be present, attentive, and intentional. May we not simply go through the motions but allow our actions to reflect a heart that truly believes.
