—St. Anthony, abbot (251-356), was born into a wealthy Egyptian family but gave away his inheritance and became a hermit, later established the first monastic community; **Saturday**—St. Fabian, pope & martyr (d.250); was bishop of Rome. A dove is said to have descended on his head to mark him as the Holy Spirit's unexpected choice to become the next pope. St. Sebastian, marty, (d.c. 300), According to traditional belief, he was killed during the Diocletianic Persecution of Christians.


