SAINTS AND FEAST DAYS OF THE WEEK: Monday—The Baptism of the Lord; **Saturday—**St. Hilary, bishop & doctor of the Church (315-367), is recognized as the patron saint of scholars, students, and theologians. His commitment to defending and explaining the Christian faith, as well as his prolific writings, make him an important figure in the history of theological thought. He was sometimes referred to as the "Hammer of the Arians" and the "Athanasius of the West".
