be filling in while Father Jolly takes a well-deserved vacation to visit his homeland of India. Let us keep Father Jolly in our prayers for a safe and restful journey!



St. Lawrence of Brindisi, priest & doctor of the Church (1559-1619) **Tuesday—**St. Mary Magdalene (first century) Wednesday—St. Bridget of Sweden, religious (1303-1373), co-patroness of Sweden and of Europe, married at age 13 and had eight children, and later started the Bridgettine Order; Thursday—St. Sharbel Makhluf, priest (1828-1898), born in Lebanon, famed for his holiness, wisdom and devotion to the Blessed Sacrament; Friday—St. James, Apostle (first century), known as James the Greater, brother of St. John and patron saint of Spain and pilgrims; Saturday—St Joachim and Anne, parents of the Blessed Virgin Mary
