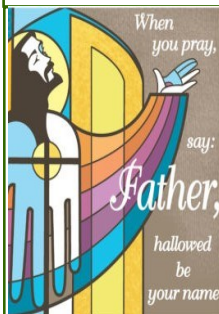

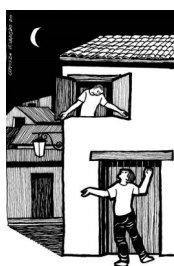

## SAINTS AND FEAST DAYS OF THE WEEK:

**Tuesday**—St. Martha, Mary, and Lazarus (first century), lived in Bethany; **Wednesday**—St. Peter Chrysologus, bishop & doctor of the Church (406c.450), earned the title Chrysologus “golden words” because of his inspirational homilies; **Thursday**—St. Ignatius of Loyola, priest (1491-1556); he began a religious conversion and a lifelong dedication to education. He wrote spiritual exercises and started a community of priests now known as the Society of Jesus (Jesuits); **Friday**—St. Alphonsus Liguori, bishop & doctor of the Church (1696-1787); founded the Redemptorists **Saturday**—St. Eusebius of Vercelli, bishop (d. 371), bishop who opposed the Arians, and St. Peter Julian Eymard, priest (1811-1868), French priest who founded the Blessed Sacrament Fathers, whose charism is to promote the significance of the Eucharist for Christian living.

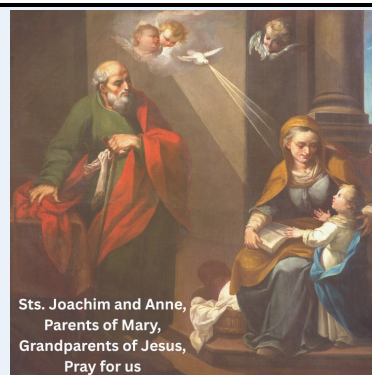

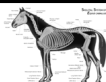
