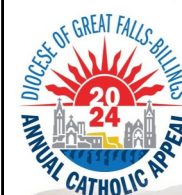

SAINTS AND FEAST DAYS OF THE WEEK: Monday—St. Casimir (1458-1484), was involved in government affairs and was renowned for his sense of justice and his care for the poor; **Thursday—St. Perpetua and St. Felicity,** martyrs (d.203), were condemned to death for refusing to renounce their Christian faith; **Friday—St. John of God,** religious (1495-1550), at age forty resolved upon an entire life change devoting himself to the service of God and helping the sick; **Saturday—St. Frances of Rome,** religious (1384-1440) married at age thirteen, had six children, and after the death of two of them took care of the poor, and the sick.

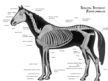
