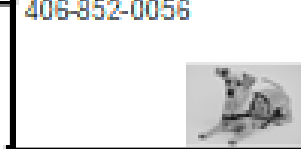

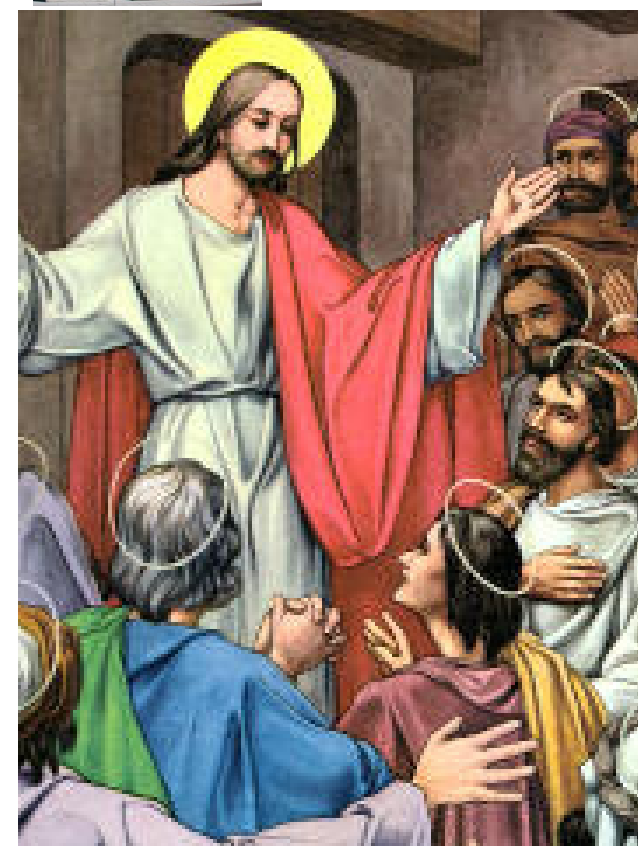

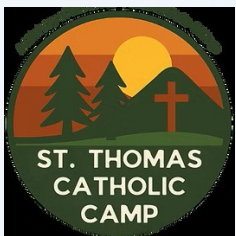
DCCW SCHOLARSHIP
