LIAM'S WISH BAGS: St. Therese Circle is collecting items for Liam's Bags. Liam McWilliams was diagnosed with Acute Leukemia in 2010. During his treatment trips to Billings and Denver, he noticed how many homeless people had very little. He made a list of items that could help them, bought the items, and put them in bags to hand out when he saw someone in need. After Liam passed away in 2011, his family continued his project, and now people in three states help make the bags each Christmas. Today, the bags are given to students in need at CCDHS and at the Soup Kitchen.

- Items needed: towels, washcloths, men's body wash, women's toiletries and sanitary items, deodorant for men and women, small blankets or throws. Travel-size items are helpful because they fit easily in backpacks.
- ⇒ **Food items:** granola bars, Cup O' Noodle, ramen, soups, canned or pouch ham and chicken, crackers, oatmeal packets, snacks.
