LIAM'S WISH BAGS: St. Therese Circle is collecting items for Liam's Bags. Liam McWilliams was diagnosed with Acute Leukemia in 2010. During his treatment trips to Billings and Denver, he noticed how many homeless people had very little. He made a list of items that could help them, bought the items, and put them in bags to hand out when he saw someone in need. After Liam passed away in 2011, his family continued his project, and now people in three states help make the bags each Christmas. Today, the bags are given to students in need at CCDHS and at the Soup Kitchen.

- ⇒ **Items NOT needed:** toothbrushes, toothpaste, hats, gloves, women's body wash, pajama pants.
- ⇒ **Items needed:** towels, washcloths, men's body wash, women's toiletries and sanitary items, deodorant for men and women, small blankets or throws. Travel-size items are helpful because they fit easily in backpacks.
- ⇒ **Food items:** granola bars, Cup O' Noodle, ramen, soups, canned or pouch ham and chicken, crackers, oatmeal packets, snacks.
- ⇒ **Special items:** small gifts like necklaces, etc.

In the United States, we aren't used to kings. We value freedom, independence, and the right to choose our own path; so a feast celebrating a *King* can feel a little foreign. But Christ's kingship isn't about control or power. It's about love, mercy, and truth, a rule that frees rather than binds, that heals rather than dominates. Christ is the King who serves His people, who wore a crown of thorns instead of gold, and whose earthly throne was a cross. To proclaim Him as King means surrendering not our freedom, but our hearts, trusting that in His reign, we find true peace.

SAINTS AND FEAST DAYS OF THE WEEK: Monday—St. Andrew Dung-Lac, priest & martyr, and Companions, martyrs (1785-1839), 117 Vietnamese people martyred between 1820-1862; **Tuesday—**St. Catherine of Alexandria, virgin & martyr (d.c.310), a woman of wisdom, courage, and unwavering faith. A brilliant young lady, Catherine boldly defended the truth of Christ before powerful rulers. Her words confounded her opponents, and her steadfast love for God inspired many to believe. Tradition tells us she suffered martyrdom in part on a spiked wheel, a symbol now forever associated with her, choosing faith over fear, and eternal life over worldly power.
