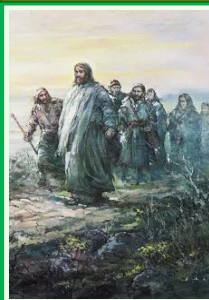

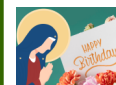

SAINTS AND FEAST DAYS OF THE WEEK: Monday—



The Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary, Today the Church celebrates the Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary. Her birth was the dawn of salvation, for through her "yes," the Light of the world entered our lives. Let's honor Our Lady today by praying a Rosary, attending Mass, or simply whispering a heartfelt "thank you" for her motherly love and intercession. Happy Birthday, Mary, our Mother! **Tuesday—**St. Peter Claver, priest (1580-1654), he joined the Jesuits and went to the missions in Caregena, Colombia (which was then the center of the slave trade). **Friday—The Most Holy Name of Mary,** Today the Church celebrates the Feast of the Holy Name of Mary—a name filled with sweetness, comfort, and strength. The very name of Mary reminds us of her motherly care and her powerful intercession. As St. Bernard of Clairvaux wrote: *"In dangers, in doubts, in difficulties, think of Mary, call upon Mary."* Let us honor her name today by calling upon it often and entrusting ourselves to her maternal love.



Saturday—St. John Chrysostom, bishop & doctor of the Church (347-407), became famous for his eloquent sermons, and was called Chrysostom ("golden mouth").

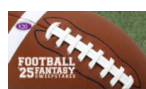

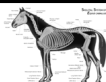
