May Procession on Wheels Honoring our Mother Mary Mother's Day Sunday, May 10 from 10:00 AM to 11:30 AM

Greetings! I am pleased to let you know that the parish will celebrate Mother's Day with a May Procession, although with a few adaptations for social distancing. Mass will be livestreamed as usual on Saturday, May 9 at 4pm. The video will be available on Sunday, Mother's Day on the parish facebook page (accessed through parish website).

On Mother's Day, a procession will drive through various parish neighborhoods to help honor the Blessed Mother and celebrate her love for her children. This small procession of vehicles with Marian hymn music, a Statue of the Blessed Virgin Mary, and a third car with a flower tribute will travel on a preplanned route.

Walk to a location nearest your home and bring a chair or stand along with your family. Pray the rosary or a Hail Mary as the May Procession drives by. The procession is unable to stop but will proceed slowly and with caution. Please let your friends and neighbors know of this devotion. The mobile May Procession will travel from 10am to 11:30am beginning in Marcus Hook, then Trainer, Linwood, Upper Chichester, Ogden, Garnet Valley and Boothwyn. As part of the route, we will proceed past Immaculate Conception, Holy Saviour and St. John Fisher Churches. A map with a full listing of streets of route is posted on the parish website and facebook page to show the exact path of the procession, so you can plan where you stand along the way.
