Discover Christ at Our Lady of the Black Hills

Have you heard the exciting news at Our Lady of the Black Hills? We are presenting the *Discovering Christ* course on Sunday evenings, September 30–November 18. Are you registered? There is still time. Do you need to know more about this opportunity? *Discovering Christ* is the first course of the *ChristLife* series and has two major goals: 1) To enter into or renew a personal relationship with Jesus Christ, experience the love of God the Father, and be empowered by the Holy Spirit to live as God's children; and 2) To learn skills to accompany others seeking Jesus. The following testimonies by two of last year's participants clearly reveal the powerful impact that *Discovering Christ* had on their lives and faith.

"Finding the Catholic Church and participating in *ChristLife* has given me a new, deeper love for our Lord. It has helped me to walk with Christ daily and to make Christ my number one priority. *ChristLife* has given me the tools needed to have a closer relationship with Christ more than ever before" (Cathy Long).

"I was asked to write to you about my experience with *Discovering Christ*. What an experience it was. We were asked personal things to think about and pray about. I have been a believer in the Holy Spirit for a long time. I have seen and been involved with some miracles done through the power of the Holy Spirit. Toward the end of *ChristLife* we were asked to write on a huge cardboard describing our experience. Everyone, including me, started thinking about great things to write. Instead of going ahead, I started to pray about what I should write. The Lord, through the Holy Spirit, spoke to me and said, 'What happened to you through this? How did it all help you?' Then He said, 'Write what you feel.' I wrote: I WAS BLIND—BUT NOW I SEE—THANK YOU JESUS FOR YOUR LOVE. When Deacon John did the video clip that has been playing for you, you'll notice that when mine comes up, the background music is 'I was blind but now I see.' When we were watching the clip, we noticed the music in the background. The Lord works in mysterious ways, His wonders to perform" (Duane Riedlinger).

Each session of *Discovering Christ* has four components that are vital to the evangelization process: Dinner, Welcome and Prayer, Video Teaching, and Small Group Discussion. There is a day-retreat after the fifth session. This is a great way for our parish to achieve our pastoral plan to make evangelization a priority and to act on our parish mission statement: Our Lady of the Black Hills exists to proclaim the joy of the Gospel to all creation and to transform lives with the mercy of the Father.

In 1965, one of the principal documents of the Second Vatican Council, the dogmatic constitution Dei verbum ("Word of God") emphasized the use of Lectio Divina. On the 40th anniversary of Dei verbum in 2005, Pope Benedict XVI reaffirmed its importance and stated: "I would like in particular to recall and recommend the ancient tradition of Lectio Divina: the diligent reading of Sacred Scripture accompanied by prayer brings about that intimate dialogue in which the person reading hears God who is speaking, and in praying, responds to him with trusting openness of heart [cf. Dei verbum, n. 25]. If it is effectively promoted, this practice will bring to the Church - I am convinced of it - a new spiritual springtime." We invite you to join us each Wednesday at Terra Sancta Retreat Center from 5:15-6:15 p.m. as we use the Sunday Gospel reading for an hour of Lectio Divina.
