The meeting opened with a share out to close Leadership Night. The Leadership Night information is included below. Erik Haakedahl gave a building committee update. He noted we are waiting on the garage project; it should start next week, the space has been prepared and the heating unit has been purchased. There is a small leak in the church roof; a roofer has been contacted. There is a leak in the baptismal font, they are looking into adding a timer to aid in pipe preservation. A meeting to discuss the parking lot maintenance has been scheduled. The second week of May the playset will be installed. A walkway from the parking lot to the set will also be completed. During open forum it was discussed that the Icon for persecuted Christians will be on display. Pastoral Ministry Days will be April 8 and 9. The Chrism Mass is Monday, April 8 at 7 PM. The Living the Mission Campaign is completed for our parish and will continue to run elsewhere until the end of June. The pilot parishes and block one parishes, including OLBH have met their goal. There will be spring stewardship on the Wednesday after Easter (4/24) and will focus on caring for God's earth with a parish landscaping project and pot luck. It was noted that it may be a good plan to have the discipleship commission meet more often. Additionally that combining leadership night with pastoral council night and having them overlap at the end/beginning seems to work well. Lastly, it was noted that the role of the commissions versus the pastoral council should be addressed, Fr. Andrzej noted that would be discussed in more detail at pastoral ministry days.
