Appropriate Eye Contact—Lector indicates familiarity with the reading and speaks directly to the congregation.

Clarity—Lector speaks clearly and distinctly; pronounces all words correctly.

Volume—Lector projects his/her voice to the back of the congregation.

Proclamation—Lector proclaims the Word of the Lord rather than just reading. He/she proclaims meaning and understanding by using pauses and a vocal range of speed, volume, and vocal expression for emphasis. Lector uses facial expression. Lector slows down toward the end of the reading and includes a period of silence.

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
