

Wednesday afternoons at 1:00 PM and Thursday evenings at 6:00 PM.




### Six Great Ideas

Mortimer J. Adler is called a "philosopher for everyman." In this guide to review the big questions, Adler addresses the topics all men and women ponder in the course of life, such as "What is love?", "How do we decide the right thing to do?", and, "What does it mean to be good?" Drawing on his extensive knowledge of Western literature, history, and philosophy, the author considers what is meant by democracy, law, emotion, language, truth, and other abstract concepts in light of more than two millennia of Western civilization and discourse. Adler's essays offer a remarkable and contemplative distillation of the Great Ideas of Western Thought.

## Course Overview

### The Book of Psalms


The Book of Psalms is a unique collection of the song-prayers of Israel. To study Psalms is to study prayer, ultimately to enter into prayer. The study will challenge participants to reflect on their own prayer and life experiences. Psalms II focuses on a selection of twenty-eight psalms divided into three categories:

- Royal Psalms
- Psalms of Lament
- Psalms of Declarative Praise

The royal psalms reflect the belief in ancient Israel that the king was “anointed” by God (i.e. a messiah) to be “the instrument of God’s concern for the people” (from the commentary, p. 79). Psalms of lament express the sorrow of the soul in distress and of the individual’s and the community’s need to turn to God in order to be healed or rescued. Psalms of declarative praise are prayers of thanks-

## National Eucharistic Revival

The Bishops of the United States are calling for a three-year grassroots revival of devotion and belief in the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. They believe that God wants to see **a movement of Catholics across the United States, healed, converted, formed, and unified by an encounter with Jesus in the Eucharist - and sent out in mission “for the life of the world.”**

These three years will culminate in the first National Eucharistic Congress in the United States in almost fifty years. Almost a hundred thousand Catholics will join together in Indianapolis for a once -in-a-lifetime pilgrimage toward the “source and summit” of our Catholic faith.

The National Eucharistic Congress will take place in Indianapolis in 2024 and will be a pivotal, unifying, and transformative moment for the Church in the United States of America. Be part of this historic event as Catholics from around the country gather together for a week centered on Eucharistic revival with liturgical worship, great speakers, workshops, and much more.


