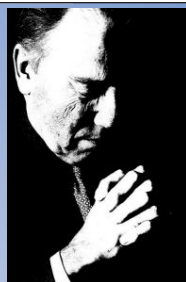

#### HEART TO SHARE

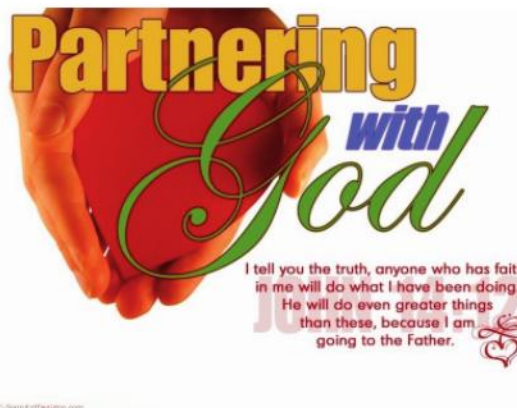


In a spirit of selfless love for God and others, *with* how much of your heart do you share your financial gifts, freely, sacrificially, and joyfully?

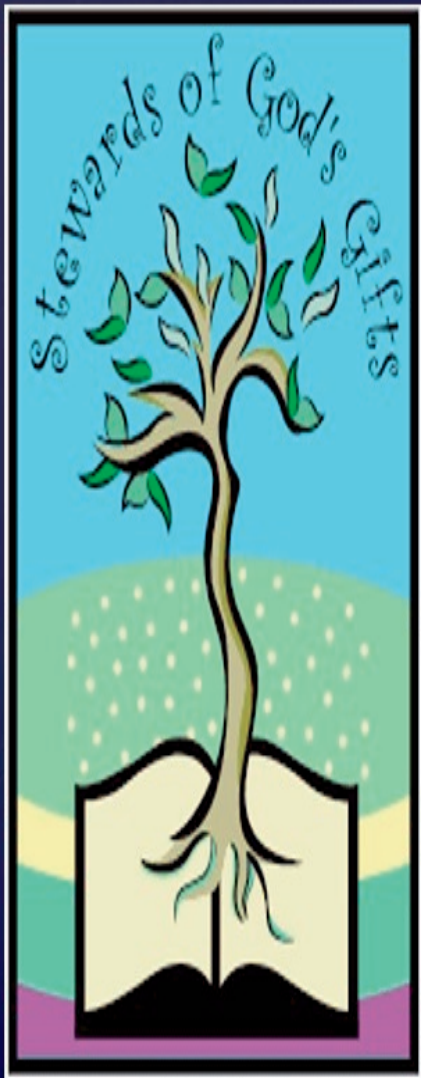

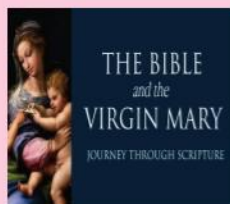
