GRAND KNIGHT REPORT

Brother Knights,

There are many Council and Parish events scheduled this month and next month along with the turning of the nice seasonal weather. With the nice rain everything has really sprung to life and greened up.

Our Council, in the last year, engaged in many projects, charitable works and donations and evangelization of our faith. Some of those efforts were documented and submitted to the Knights of Columbus State Program Director. Even though it looks like bragging, about our Council, they are needed as the Program Director compiles the state Knights efforts and submits them to the Knights of Columbus Supreme Program Director. That information is published to spread the ways evangelization is taking place. Other councils can be inspired and or get ideas that they can implement in their local communities.

Last weekend the State Knights of Columbus Convention was held in Kearney and was attended by 159 State Councils. Two delegates from each council were requested to attend and many other Council members were there also.

Good representation from the Squires and Insurance agents was seen and they had information and auction items on tables. The business meetings were informative and progressed smoothly. Only one cell phone went off and it was the State photographer who stepped in for a look. He then paid his \$10 to the State Foundation. At the awards ceremony 80 Councils out of 159 received recognition. These awards are from the Council members being active and someone documenting and submitting those activities. 30 Councils received third place in the new Inter Council Competition format and we received one of those awards. Five first place contenders were voted on by the jurisdiction and First place was awarded to Blessed Sacrament Council in Lincoln Nebraska. So they display the wrestling styled belt for the next year and it gets awarded to the following year's first place winner.

The Knights of Columbus Supreme recognized our Council for the Culture of life with our Pro-Life Education Series. We would like to display all of the Council awards for the parish and community to see and that is where the rolling display that someone will make comes into play. Many Councils display them in the church narthex, entry way or frequently used social halls for parishioners and visitors to peruse and take photos of.

We are getting setup for a membership drive, Join Hands day, Memorial Day at Calvary Cemetery, St Patrick Catholic School barbeque, Jason Doher Diaconate, Family Picnic, Fireworks Stand and so forth.

Take a look at the calendar and consider helping with some event. Let's help the new members by inviting them and engaging them in functions.

Please continue to pray for all parishioners and Knights who are so charitable with their resources in the New Spiritual Home oak trim project. Since you are reading this you participate in our fraternity. 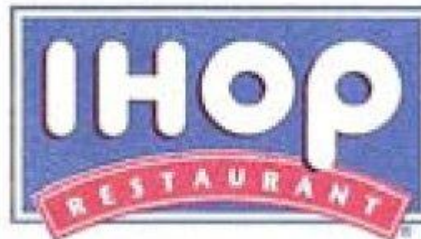
