This past year brought shocking "Brave New World" revelations in biomedical research, including genetic engineering breakthroughs using a gene editing tool called CRISPR-Cas9.

As I write this, news just broke revealing a new clinical trial initiated by China that seeks to cure cancer in adults using the CRISPR-Cas9. This is an exciting and ethical use of the new tool that NCER can endorse. However, human nature always seems to push some people across that ethical line to change something good into something destructive. How long before "designer babies" and "trans-human" people are created, making anyone who is "imperfect" unwanted and unacceptable? Closer to home, the state of Nebraska continues to allow UNMC to conduct new embryonic research and continued experimentation using fetal tissue from elective abortions.

The Board at NCER would like to take this opportunity to express our heartfelt thanks to you for faithfully partnering with us over this past year in our shared mission to stand for the life, dignity and rights of every human being at each developmental stage.

Progress in 2016 at NCER:


