When Life Begins: A Reminder

Recently, I was listening to radio station outside of Lincoln. The host of show was interviewing well known TV personality who has emphasized he's pro-life. The subject of abortion came up. I was both shocked and angry when this credibly pro-life, well known personality stated "Nobody knows when life begins." It's tragic when such ignorance is broadcast to the general public.

When our council began our Pro-Life Education Series, first speaker was Fr. Christopher Kubat and title of his talk was "When does life begin?" Father is a priest and a physician. We learned that human life begins at conception -- the fertilization of the female egg. Life begins in the Fallopian tube not in the uterus. As Fr. Kubat would tell you "any standard embryology text" contains same information as to when human life begins.(Love Library would have these texts).
