**Home & School Report:** Account Balances; Checking: \$52,343.85, CD's : \$ 55,978.67. The officers will be sending out a survey to all school families to seek input on Christmas Bazaar activities. **Athletic Report:** Account Balances; Checking: \$7,324.79, Savings: \$ 8,825.20. Volleyball games started tonight. New Padded chairs have been ordered for school.

**Pastor's Report:** Msgr went over the Finances of the parish with all of us. He mentioned that we have begun to make payments on the painting of the church. July and August are slow months for donations. Wed September 11<sup>th</sup> will begin confirmation for grades 7<sup>th</sup>-11<sup>th</sup> grade. Approximately 60 kids will be confirmed this year. Confirmation kids will need to have 20 hours of community service. Msgr bragged on Mr. Stobart and how he is keeping things running smoothly.
