  - Limitation: Money & time to update technology.
    - Not clear on who is in charge of updating/making a plan for technology
  - Strategies: Reestablish a technology committee

  - Figure out funding
- \* **GOAL #3:** Provide professional development training that aligns with the needs of the staff
  - Limitation: Cost
    - Time away from teaching or school
    - Willingness to learn new concepts
    - Various levels of content areas amongst the staff
  - Strategies: budgeting and allowance for research
    - Schedule training opportunities for group or individual needs
- \* **GOAL #4:** To continue to implement the diocesan language arts & math learning standards and measure the impact on student achievement.
  - Limitation: time
  - Strategies: schedule time with peers to collaborate and learn & understand the new curriculum
    - Accept everyone processes differently
- \* **GOAL #5:** Increase academic rigor in all classes by providing students with opportunities to develop their critical thinking and reasoning skills.
  - Limitation: time; how to get students comfortable feeling “uncomfortable” when learning and experiencing new skills.
  - Strategies: focus on one concept and build from there allowing the staff to become familiar or master that concept
