Why do we choose Confirmation Saints?

Part of the Confirmation process is to choose a saint who will become a patron saint for you. This isn't just something to check off a list, but rather, should be the beginning of a lifelong friendship with someone who chose to follow Christ in another time and place, successfully lived out their discipleship, and now can intercede for you to Christ in heaven. Your Confirmation saint can also serve as a role model and example of how to attain holiness and grow in the spiritual life.

The name of the saint you choose is the name you will be confirmed under.

How do I choose my Saint?

Take some time to research and find a saint to whom you can make a personal connection. Choose a saint that you want to imitate. Perhaps he/she had the same struggle or difficulty in life as you; perhaps they had similar hobbies, interests, or personality. Maybe they held a profession you would like to pursue. Or perhaps they are connected to a particular country or period in history you find interesting.

You are allowed to keep your baptismal name only if it is the name of a saint; and your saint's gender must match your own.

WISDOM : the gift of the Spirit enabling us to see things from God's point of view; to realize the real value of people, events, & things.	KNOWLEDGE : the gift of the Spirit helping us know what God wants of us and how He wants us to respond in certain situations.
UNDERSTANDING : the gift of the Spirit providing us with insight into the truths of the faith and being a follower of Jesus in his Catholic Church.	REVERENCE (PIETY) : the gift of the Spirit that helps us to love and worship God by recognizing we are His children (also known as PIETY).
RIGHT JUDGMENT (COUNSEL): the Spirit's gift helping us to seek advice and be open to advice given to us by the Spirit through others.	WONDER & AWE (FEAR OF THE LORD) : the Spirit's gift to help us recognize the greatness of God and our dependence on him.
COURAGE (FORTITUDE) : the Spirit's gift of strength to persevere in the faith and stand up for beliefs in order to live as a follower of Jesus.
