



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Is the Online Homeschool Option offered for all grades?

Yes, all students in grades 1-8 may enroll in Online Homeschool Faith Formation.

Can my child switch back and forth between in-person and online classes?

No, students must enroll in either in-person or online courses for the entire year.

My child has missed a year or more of Faith Formation classes. Can they take a course over the summer to “catch up”?

Yes, students may take an online Faith Formation course over the summer to catch up on any years they may have missed. *Note: As of September 2022, students will be enrolled in Faith Formation according to the last grade level they completed.*

Can my child take two courses in one year to “catch up”?

It is permitted for children to take more than one course in a given year in order to get back on track; however, I have never had a child actually complete two whole courses in one year. Students will be enrolled in one course at a time. If they complete their first course successfully, they may be enrolled in the next grade level.

If my child has missed a year of Faith Formation, can they take the missed year online while attending the next grade in-person?

No, each grade level builds upon the previous year. Students must successfully complete each grade level of Faith Formation before moving on to the next.

I would like to homeschool my child for Faith Formation but I am concerned about screen time. Is there a book option?

No, in order to assess students' progress through their courses, we will be using the online program only. Please note that it takes students an average of 15-20 minutes to complete each online lesson.

How many lessons are there in each grade level?

Each grade level has about 25 lessons, an average of one lesson per week throughout the school year.
