

#### Did You Know?

Our current church building was officially dedicated on December 14, 1997 by Bishop Robert W. Muench. With a capacity of over 800 persons, it was quite a bit larger than the structures that had previously been built in 1880 and 1919. Joining Bishop Muench and Pastor Fr. Paul Berschied at the dedication were previous pastors, Fr. Robert Urlage and Fr. David Shockey, as well as retired Bishop William Hughes, who had helped break ground for the facility in 1990. The new church was a wonderful combination of items from the 1919 church and new architectural elements and immediately ranked as one of the most beautiful churches in the diocese.
