Holy Week is upon us. Beginning today, Palm Sunday, and running through Holy Saturday, this is the most significant week in Catholicism. Let us all use this sacred week to pray and reflect upon Jesus' suffering and sacrifice for our sakes. Then, after this solemn week of remembrance, we'll be able to joyously celebrate Jesus' resurrection next week on Easter Sunday.

Please try your best to attend as many Holy Week services as you can. If Jesus can give his life for us, we should at least try to give him a bit of our time during this holiest of weeks. We will have Mass on Holy Thursday beginning at 7:00 pm, followed by adoration until midnight. On Good Friday, we commemorate the Passion of our Lord at 3:00 pm, and will pray the Solemn Stations of the Cross at 7:00 pm. Easter Vigil Mass begins at 8:30 pm on Holy Saturday, with all of our candidates and catechumens being accepted into the Church. Then, we have our Easter Sunday Masses at 9:00 am and 11:00 am. Let's give this week to Christ.

Please be advised that the church offices will be closed on Holy Thursday and Good Friday, as well as Monday, April 1st. The business office will reopen on Tuesday, April 2nd. Also note that Father Harry will be out of town April 1st through April 5th. There will be no daily Mass or adoration/benediction that week.

Next Saturday will be our annual Easter Egg Hunt, which will begin promptly after the blessing of the Easter baskets, which begins at 9:30 am. This is a wonderful and fun event that just gets bigger and better every year, so be sure to bring the kids for a great time.

If you've ever thought of joining the Altar Society, you should! 
