


Jan. 2024: 29 calls including 10 from the No Help Areas. Help was given in the way of 6 food deliveries, 6 utilities paid, 4 clothing vouchers, 2 furniture vouchers, 1 household voucher, 1 gas card and 1 bed provided. Dec ending treasury balance was \$ 7,496.91. Our balance at the end of Jan was \$6181.75

Feb. 2024: 31 calls including 5 No Help Areas. 15 food deliveries were made, 7 utilities bills paid, 3 clothing vouchers, 1 furniture voucher and 1 household voucher were provided. The Feb ending balance was \$4,368.49

In summary the first 2 months of 2024 were very busy, the need is great. Our parish has helped support over 30 families through SVDP so far this year. As you can see it's also draining our treasury by \$3128.42 in just 2 months. God Bless each member of St. Cecilia's Parish for your help and support making this work possible!
