State of the School Address

Enrollment for Next Year

Enrollment packets will be sent home with the students today for our current families. If an extra enrollment form is needed for a new sibling to our school, please request from the office. Enrollment for new families begins on February 1st. Please be sure to enroll your students early for next year to secure placement in the class. Many of our classes are at capacity this year and may fill up quickly for next year.

Parking Lot Safety

We have been experiencing some lapses in our drop off and pick up procedures. Several cars have been seen trying to exit out onto Oklahoma Avenue instead of following the established traffic route onto 60th St. during drop off and pick-up times. Also, some drivers are driving across the parking lot through the marked slots towards the exit instead of driving down the rows as advised. The pick-up and drop off procedures are put in place for the safety of our students and their families. Please refer to the parent handbook or the school website to review the parking lot procedures. Also, please give this information to your transportation providers so they are aware of the expectations of the parking lot procedures.

Report Cards

The Archdiocese has made a change in our report card function in PowerSchool, which has caused us a few technical complications with formatting and printing the report cards. We are in the process of trying to resolve these issues before our planned distribution of the report cards this Friday. Should these issues not be resolved by then, we will postpone the distribution of report cards until the following week.

Please send extra clothing with your students should something become too wet and uncomfortable to wear in the classroom. We can offer a few items to our students when they forget, but there seems to be an increase in forgetfulness lately.
