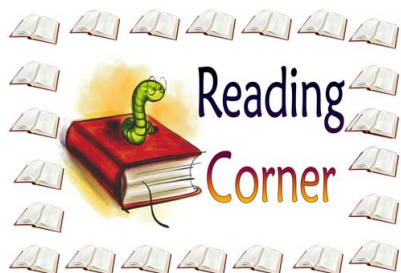

Welcome to the first Reading Corner! Here you will find updates on reading news at St. Greg's, upcoming literacy events around Milwaukee, and new book releases.

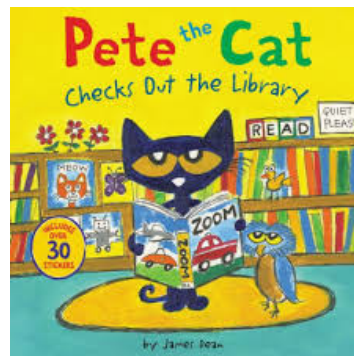
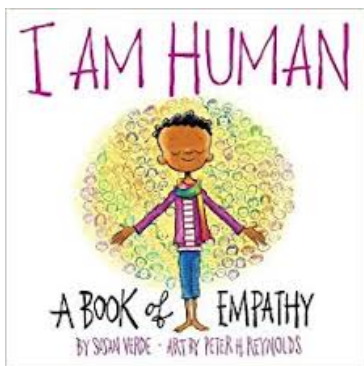
