Youth Faith Formation

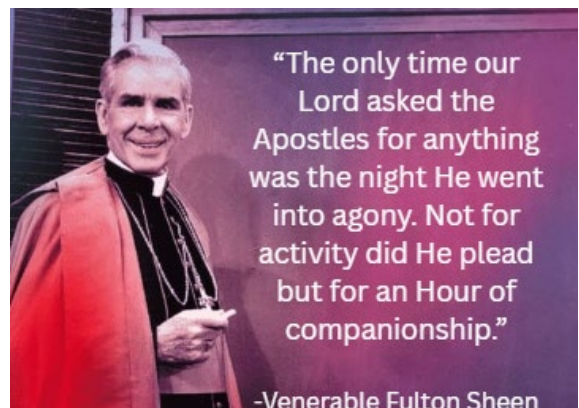
