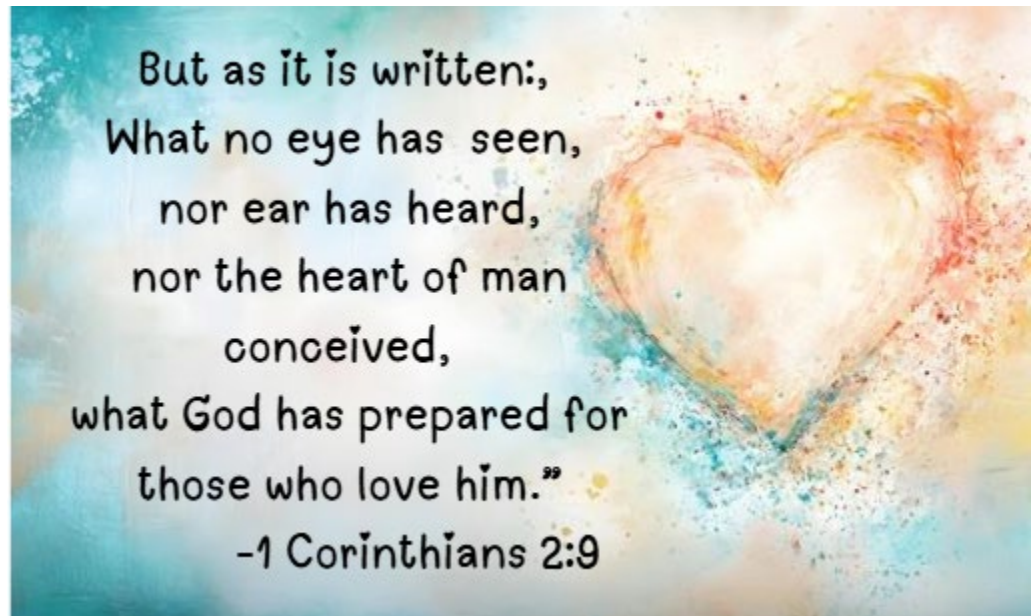

Dear Parishioners and Visitors of St. Mark and St. Paul,

The forty-day journey of Lent begins Wednesday with Ash Wednesday. Mass will be 9 AM at St. Mark and 6:30 PM at St. Paul. Stations of the Cross will be on Thursdays after the 9 AM Mass at St. Mark and at 6 PM at St. Paul on Fridays.

From my earliest memories I knew there was something different about Lent. My mother would take us to church on Friday nights for stations of the cross. Or we would go to church on a Wednesday night, and the priest would have Mass at one of the side altars or he would do benediction. Why a side altar? I do not know. I do know it was right after Vatican II and the altar facing the people had just happened. For an eight- or nine-year-old I just knew we were going to church an extra time during the week so it must have been important. The other thing I remember is that we normally got off the school bus at 3 PM. My mom would have us sitting around the kitchen table and we would pray the rosary. We were upset about that because that was when Dark Shadows came on television and we wanted to watch this program.

One other thing I remember so well was our Friday night suppers. We would often have tuna fish (which I did not like at the time) or vegetable soup with no meat. But my dad (who is of the Baptist faith) got eggs and bacon. Now, how could an eight-year-old understand that dynamic? You are talking about feeling left out. Just watching my dad eat that bacon – well that was totally unfair! My mother had to dread Friday night suppers during Lent. Every time she got the same question. Why mom? Why can't I have some bacon?

May God bless your Lenten journey.

Lent Fasting and Abstinence

The sick, pregnant, nursing, or those whose health would be compromised are not bound by the following rules.

Fasting : Limit eating to one full meal and two smaller meals, required on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday, for those **18–59**

Abstinence: Not eating meat on Fridays during Lent is a **lifelong obligation beginning at 14** .

Fridays Outside of Lent: In the U.S., Catholics are obliged to perform some form of penance (abstinence from meat or another sacrifice) on all other Fridays of the year.

Every **Friday** from **Feb 20 to March 20**, the **KofC Fish Fry** will have both shrimp and fish meals. Meals will include two pieces of fish or eight shrimp plus hush puppies, white beans, slaw, and French fries for \$13.00 per meal. Meals can be picked up from 3:30 to 5:30 pm in the Parish Center. All proceeds will be used to continue the Knight's charitable programs. Take the night off from the kitchen and let the Knights cook dinner.
