Dear Parishioners and Visitors of St. Mark and St. Paul,

On Friday of this past week, we celebrated the feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. The history of this feast is varied. But originally it goes back to Good Friday and the wounds of Jesus and specifically the lance that pierced Jesus in the side and blood and water flowed out. The devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus is a practice centering on the physical heart of Jesus as a symbol of His boundless, divine love for humanity. The feast of the Sacred Heart is celebrated sixty-eight days after Easter, which is always the Friday following the second Sunday after Pentecost. There are two churches in our diocese that have the name of Sacred Heart: one is in Union County and the other is in Russellville.

The yard sale made about \$2100.00. Thank you to all who helped in any way. A special thank you to those who helped to clean up and take the leftovers to St. Vincent DePaul in Paducah. This money will go a long way in supporting our youth next year.
