Youth Faith Formation Teacher Needed

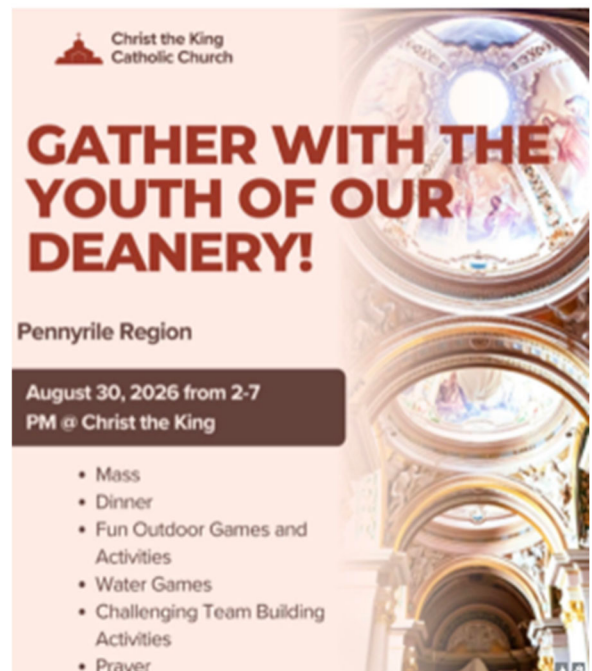
