Our Prayer Chain Ministry is the life blood of the congregation...a gift given, expecting nothing in return.

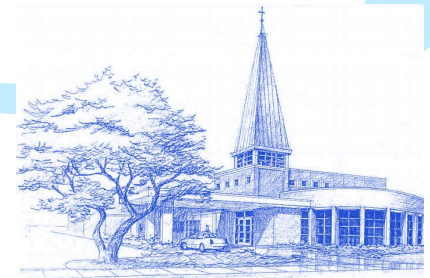
