Adult Choir (Age 15+)

Enhance the liturgy through prayerful reflection in song, singing from Sept. to May. Ability to read



music helpful, but not required. All parish members and high school students are welcome to join.

Time: Rehearsals, once a week, 6:30 - 8:30 pm on Tuesdays. Members are required to be present 30 minutes prior to Mass. The adult choir also participates in occasional liturgies, special feasts, and seasonal concerts.

Handbell Choir (5th Grade through Adult)

Assist the community in worship through the artistry of bell ringing. No experience necessary, but ability to read music and count rhythm is helpful. All parish members 5th grade and



above are welcome. Time: Rehearsals, once a week, for 90 minutes. September through Pentecost, based off of members' availability.

Resurrection Choir

Provide music to complement and enhance the funeral liturgies and memorial Masses. Time: Need to be present 15 minutes before liturgies.

Open to all parishioners. Ability to read music helpful, but not required. Appropriate dress is required.



Children's Choir (3rd Grade and up)

Students in Grades 3 and up are welcome to join the Children's Choir. This group practices weekly and sings at school masses and occasional weekends/ holidays. Ability to read music is not required.



Worship Band

Enhance worship by incorporating contemporary Christian music.

Time: This group plays approximately once per month at Mass.

Cantor Ministry

Proclaim the Word of God through leadership of the Responsorial Psalm and hymn singing. Cantors lead the parish community in worship at all Masses. *Time: Typically serve once or twice a month.*

Musicians

Add to the ambiance of liturgy with instruments like piano, flute, drum, guitar, or cello. If you have a talent that can be shared, please contact the Director of Liturgy.

Time: As needed.

Music assessment is required for Cantor and Musicians. Ability to read music helpful, but not required. Appropriate dress is required while serving the Lord in this ministry.



Lectors

A lector proclaims the Word of God to the congregation at Mass and allows God to reach the hearts and understanding of God's people. Training will be provided.

Time: Approximately once a month.

Ushers/Hospitality Ministers

Our Hospitality Ministers provide an environment of love and care for parish members, guests, and friends, in order to enhance their worship and provide a welcoming space. This is a wonderful ministry for entire families to participate in.

Time: Approximately once or twice a month.

Altar Servers (4th Grade and up)

To be an Altar Server is a beautiful way for our young parishioners to serve God and actively participate in the liturgical life of St. Charles Borromeo. To serve at the Altar is a great privilege and honor and requires a willingness to serve, dedication, discipline, and a prayerful attitude.
