








Examples?

Covenant [kuhv-uh-nuhnt] *noun* 1. a solemn agreement in which mutual commitments are made; implies more than a contract or a simple agreement between two parties



Foreshadow [fôr'Shadō] *verb* 1. a warning or indication of a future event.

(synonyms: signal, indicate, signify, mean, be a sign of, suggest, herald, be a harbinger of, warn of, portend, prefigure, presage, promise, anticipate)


