

Archindy CYO Team Placement Policy

This policy will be in place for kickball, girls basketball, boys basketball and all volleyball leagues.

Placement of Teams Within Leagues, Team Rosters, Team Entries, Team Drop Fees and Registration Information – PLEASE READ VERY CAREFULLY AND KEEP THIS INFORMATION FOR YOUR PARISH/SCHOOL RECORDS

If a parish enters one team into an athletic program, it must be in the “A” league.

The larger schools will be entered into the American League and the smaller schools will primarily be entered into the National League.

If a parish enters two teams into an athletic program, one team must be in the “A” league and one must be in the “B” league. However, you may have more than one “A” team.

If a parish enters three teams into an athletic program, one must be in the “A” league. The other two teams can be entered into the “B” league or one can be entered into the “B” league and one can be entered into the “C” league.

If a parish enters more than three teams into an athletic program, one team must be entered into the “A” league. The other teams can be entered into the “B” and “C” leagues as the parish sees fit. However, it is important to note that a parish can never enter more “C” league teams than it does “B” league teams for any sport.

If any of the teams are not entered into the appropriate leagues when they are submitted, as designated above, the **CYO Office staff** will place the teams into the proper league or leagues.

3rd and 4th Grade Leagues

There will be no “A”, “B” or “C” levels for 3rd and 4th grade leagues. 3rd and 4th grade leagues are developmental leagues meant to focus on the fundamentals of the game to prepare for the next level of play. If you have more than one team in any of these leagues, they should be split evenly. One team should not be of higher-level talent than the other.

Team Rosters

There will be a designated roster deadline for each sport. Late roster submission is also subject to a late entry charge. The CYO Staff, upon the roster deadline, will check to be sure that all team rosters have been submitted online. **There must be a roster submitted for every team entered into every CYO athletic league and there will be no exceptions. If a roster is not submitted for a team, that team may be in jeopardy for postseason play.**

Team Entries

Teams must be entered by the designated deadline. All deadlines are published on the CYO Calendar, which is available 24-7 on the CYO Website. In the past we have been very lenient about entry deadlines and also entering teams via email and phone messages from Athletic

Directors. For several years we have not enforced any late entry charges for teams, rosters and drop fees. **It will now be the total responsibility of all ADs and designated coordinators to enter your teams by the team entry deadline.**

Team Drop Fees

If a parish/school drops a team after the entry deadline, but prior to the scheduling process beginning, a team drop fee will be charged. If a team drops after the scheduling process begins the full team entry fee will be charged.

Participants and coaches

All participants and coaches must be registered in the CYO Website. You are not able to assign a participant to a roster if he or she is not registered. A coach cannot be assigned to a team if he or she is not registered.
